When shopping for an accompanist, remember that you get what you pay for. While your piano player won't be judged, if they're unprepared they could accidentally mess you up!

With your fee you should get at least one rehearsal, or perhaps 2. Make sure you ask how many practices and where they rehearse at. You are welcome to use one of the pianos at Eisenhower if need be, just let Mr. Traskal know.

Remember, you should be rehearsing with your accompanist, NOT practicing! Know your piece VERY well before you try putting it with the piano or its going to be a waste of everyone's time. BE PREPARED!

If you're taking private lessons, your lesson teacher may have other accompanists that use can as well.
