To ensure that Band Camp is a safe and positive experience for everyone, all students must follow this Eisenhower H.S. Band Camp Code of Conduct.

As a student member of the Eisenhower Instrumental Music Program, it is understood that:

- ◆ I will comply with all UCS school board policies including the use of tobacco, alcohol and drugs (unless under a prescription) and with the camp rules established for the instrumental program.
- ◆ I will follow the UCS dress code.
- ◆ No hazing is allowed. See UCS policy in the Marching Registration Packet
- ◆ I will conduct myself in a proper manner at ALL TIMES. Be respectful and cooperate with my fellow students, chaperones, and staff.
- ◆ Stealing, destroying or taking student's personal belongings will not be tolerated.
- ◆ Room/cabin visitation by males and females IS NOT ALLOWED under any circumstances!!
- ◆ I will be on time and participate in all activities. No exceptions!
- ◆ I will be responsible for my instrument and respect all other instruments/equipment.
- ◆ Tennis shoes must be worn during outside rehearsals. Hats and Camelbacks (water backpacks) are also a very good idea.
- ◆ All students are expected to keep their rooms clean and pick up after themselves.
- ◆ TV's, portable DVD players, video players, personal gaming systems, personal computers, etc. are NOT allowed.
- ◆ Students will stay in groups; never walk alone.
- ◆ No visitors allowed during the camp week.
- ◆ I will be positive, have a great time, and foster a spirit of mutual support and camaraderie.
- ◆ Good common sense remains the best advice. If in doubt, don't do it or don't bring it!

I understand that my conduct will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Directors, Instructional Staff, and the Chaperones/Camp Staff. I also understand that failure to comply with any of the above Code of Conduct will be considered grounds for disciplinary action and could result in being asked to leave camp early and return home at my parents/guardians expense. As part of my discipline for abusing school policies I could be suspended and dropped from the Marching Eagles.

EISENHOWER HS "MARCHING EAGLES" ATTENDANCE CONTRACT

Marching Band is a co-curricular activity. **Participation** in the marching band requires all students to enroll in one of the qualifying **Instrumental Music** Classes at Eisenhower, Malow, Shelby, or UAIS for the entire school year. There must also be a commitment from **students** who choose to be a part of the group to be on time to **ALL** rehearsals and performances. This may mean rearranging work schedules or other activities. **Parents** must ensure that students will be on time to all rehearsals and performances. *Unlike many sports teams, there is no way of substituting for players who do not attend or do not perform up to this standard. Failure to participate continuously will be detrimental to the Marching Eagles as a whole.*

I. SCHEDULE

I have received the schedule of activities for the year (before registering for the ensemble), and I make the commitment to attend all rehearsals and performances.

II. PREPARATION

I make the commitment to come to all rehearsals fully prepared with my instrument/equipment in good working order, all necessary materials (music, drill charts, coordinate sheets, etc.), and wearing appropriate clothing, shoes, and attire.

III. ATTENDANCE

I understand that attendance at all rehearsals and performances are mandatory unless prior arrangements have been made in accordance with the policies laid out in the "**Marching Eagles Attendance Policy**". The Band Directors may make individual exceptions based on specific circumstances, however it is the expectation that all students attend all official Marching Eagle events. *Note: Summer Sectionals for Wind/Brass/Guard/Drumline are not considered official events, however are strongly encouraged.*

I also understand that failure to adhere to the "Marching Eagles Attendance Policy" may result in disciplinary action, loss of gym credit exemption, and/or removal from the ensemble. If my attendance or behavior jeopardizes the success of the group, the directors have the right to withdraw me from the marching band.

Season Rehearsals and Performances:

- All absence requests for official Marching Eagles Activities **MUST** go through the Directors.
- **AN EXCUSED ABSENCE MUST BE APPROVED BY THE BAND DIRECTORS. SIMPLY TURNING IN AN ABSENCE FORM DOES NOT MEAN THE ABSENCE IS EXCUSED.**
- **2 un-excused tardies** will turn into/result in **1 un-excused absence.**
- **Please refer to the "Marching Eagles Attendance Policy" for all excusal criteria/protocols**

NOTIFICATION OF AN ABSENCE (other than illness) MUST BE SUBMITTED TO MR. TRASKAL ON AN ABSENCE FORM (Paper Copy or Emailed/PDF) 2 WEEKS AHEAD FOR REHEARSALS OR 4 WEEKS FOR PERFORMANCES/CAMPS

- **Excused** absences as outlined in the attendance policy are personal illness, death in the family, day of religious conviction, medical emergencies, approved school events, and pre-arranged absences
- **Un-excused** absences are: work, avoidable appointments, homework, senior pictures, and non-approved absences.

STUDENT/PARENT CONTRACT

Eisenhower Instrumental Music Boosters Santa's Craft Castle

Welcome to the 2018 Eisenhower Instrumental Music season! Eisenhower has an award-winning music program that continues to flourish due to the dedication of the students, directors and parents. Each year, all the parents and students of the Instrumental Music Program (Marching Band, Concert Band, Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, and Jazz Ensemble) work together on a one-day fundraising event called Santa's Craft Castle.

The Holiday Craft Castle is the largest annual fundraiser of the program. As such, the money earned helps pay for sheet music for all bands, student awards, instruments, helps defer costs/fees for band camp, year-end banquet for all students, clinicians for the entire school year, Jazz Festival/Competition at CMU, expenses for the Florida/Disney Trip (or other long-distance travel), scholarships, plus much more!

For over 30 years, the Eisenhower Instrumental Music Boosters (**all the Band/Colorguard/Jazz parents**) have hosted this event the Saturday before Thanksgiving. Over the years, our craft show has become one of the best craft shows in our local area.

While it is a one-day event, there is much preparation that occurs prior to the event. The day before the event, many hands are needed to help with set up including booth spaces, hanging of signs, kitchen and bake sale set up to name but a few. The day of the event, it is all hands-on deck as there are many jobs including ticket sales, helping vendors unload into the building, running the kitchen, and our awesome bake sale! **To accomplish all these tasks, each student/family is asked to donate 10 hours of time** (traditionally, it has been divided as 5 hours per student and 5 hours from parents) as well as a donation to the bake sale. Any student that needs volunteer/service hours for groups such as National Honor Society can also apply Craft Castle time towards that goal! We will sign off on the student's form right after the event. This is an event you won't want to miss, so please mark your calendars now!

To coordinate such a large event, parent team leaders are needed for each area. **We are asking parents of freshmen and sophomore students to consider signing up to shadow current team leaders to learn the ropes and then be the team leader for next year.** In most cases, this involves a meeting or two prior to the event, helping coordinate set up of your area the day/evening prior to the event and your attendance and help in your designated area the day of the event.

If being a team leader is something you are unable to complete, you will still be able to sign up to work your shifts at www.santascraftcastle.com once the sign up is posted in the fall. This is an AMAZING opportunity to volunteer and help raise funds that will directly benefit your student! Thank you for helping to continue the award-winning legacy of the Eisenhower Instrumental Music Program.
